Proposition (Prop) 56 funds to OOH and the impact on funded organizations. Please note, the information in this letter is not applicable to Local Health Jurisdiction grant agreements.

Why the Update is Needed:

Effective FY 2018-19, Prop 56, California Healthcare, Research, and Prevention Tobacco Act of 2016 funds are continuously appropriated to the following departments: Department of Public Health, Department of Education, Department of Justice, University of California, and the

Department of Tax and Fee Administration.

Effective Date: JULY 1,2018

Revision Requests: The expenditure of funds by the OOH funded organizations

continues to be governed by specific grant/contract language used to administer the scope of work and budget. OOH funded organizations are to spend funds according to the FY in which they were budgeted and for actual expenses consistent with the requirements of the grant/contract and the approved spending plan. It is the responsibility of each agency to submit timely, complete, and accurate invoices for actual expenses incurred. All funds are to be liquidated to the extent possible by the end of each annual budget period based on actual

expenses.
