




# Status of Oral Health in California




- Oral diseases are highly prevalent





#### Goal 2:


Assess and address the needs of Children, Pregnant Women, People with Diabetes and Oral & Pharyngeal Cancer, and Vulnerable populations






#### **Goal 3 Strategies:**




#### **Goal 4 Communication Strategies:**
