


SOLAR PANELS: LIFT THEM SAFELY!

No.1



Never climb ladders while carrying solar panels.

Always use lifting equipment whenever possible, such as ladder hoists, swing hoists, or truck-mounted cranes/conveyors.

If lifting equipment is not used, manually lift panels to the roof using ropes, platforms, or other methods in accordance with best manual materials handling practices.
