FEE INCREASE EFFECTIVE July 1, 2022

Effective July 1, 2022, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH), Food and Drug Branch (FDB) is scheduled to increase licensing fees by five percent pursuant to the California Health and Safety Code (H&SC) Section 111656.1 authorizing CDPH to establish and adjust licensing fees to cover the estimated program costs.

The rate increase for the new fees was determined by CDPH working closely with the California Department of Finance (DOF) and will allow the fund to remain viable and cover the costs of program operations for the next fiscal year. CDPH will continue to work closely with DOF to re-evaluate in future years.
