1. Where is the Bone Densitometry Permit Application?

Effective October 1, 2018, the term X-ray Bone Densitometry was repealed and replaced with the term Dual Energy X-ray Absorptiometry (DEXA.) The DEXA application has replaced the Bone Densitometry application. Application forms are located on our Forms Page. (https://www.cdph.ca.gov/Programs/CEH/DRSEM/Pages/RHB-Certification/AppsFAQs.aspx)

2. If I have already applied for the Bone Densitometry permit, will I need to reapply for the Dual Energy X-ray Absorptiometry (DEXA) permit?

No, if you already have an application on file prior to October 1, 2018, you do not need to re-apply or make any changes to your application on file.

3. Will the Radiologic Health Branch continue to accept the Bone Densitometry Application?

The Bone Densitometry Permit Application will be accepted until February 1, 2019. After February 1, 2019, the Bone Densitometry Permit Application will not be accepted and the application will be returned.

4. I currently possess a Bone Densitometry Permit; will I need to apply for the Dual Energy X-ray Absorptiometry (DEXA) permit?

No, the Bone Densitometry Permit and the Dual Energy X-ray Absorptiometry (DEXA) permit are interchangeable, therefore there is no reason to re-apply.
