REGULATIONS AFFECTING MINIMUM STOCKING REQUIRMEMENTS

Division (CDPH/WIC) is notifying all WIC authorized vendors that effective June

1, 2021 all Temporary Food Delivery System Regulations will terminate.

Background On September 30, 2020 CDPH/WIC posted temporary food delivery system

regulations. The repeal of temporary food delivery system regulations and the

WIC Bulletin Regulations section 71100 are available for review.

**Action for** Effective June 1, 2021 all WIC vendors and WIC vendor applicants must meet the **Vendors** 

minimum stocking requirements specified in WIC Bulletin Regulations section

71100.
