TO: ALL WIC VENDORS

SUBJECT: NOTICE OF REPEAL OF TEMPORARY FOOD DELIVERY SYSTEM REGULATIONS AFFECTING MINIMUM STOCKING REQUIREMENTS

Purpose The California Department of Public Health, Women, Infants and Children Division (CDPH/WIC) is notifying all WIC authorized vendors that effective June 1, 2021 all Temporary Food Delivery System Regulations will terminate.

Background On September 30, 2020 CDPH/WIC posted [temporary food delivery system regulations](#). The [repeal of temporary food delivery system regulations](#) and the [WIC Bulletin Regulations section 71100](#) are available for review.

Action for Vendors Effective June 1, 2021 all WIC vendors and WIC vendor applicants must meet the minimum stocking requirements specified in WIC Bulletin Regulations section 71100.
