SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION OF CANNED BEANS, EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2021

The California Department of Public Health, Women, Infants and Children **Purpose**

Division (CDPH/WIC) is notifying all WIC authorized vendors that canned beans will be authorized for participants over 12 months of age as a new option in the

legumes category.

To enhance the food package, CDPH/WIC is expanding the legumes benefit to Background

add canned beans to all packages that currently receive dry beans and/or peanut

butter.

CDPH/WIC is reminding all vendors to continue to download the Authorized **Action for** Product List (APL) daily to ensure participants have access to all current Vendors

authorized foods. In the past, canned beans were only approved for a very limited group of participants. With the expansion to include more participants who can purchase canned beans, you may experience an increase in the sale of canned

beans for WIC transactions.

Please note: There is no change to processing a WIC Card transaction. Cashiers should continue to rely on the WIC EBT system to approve or decline WIC Card

purchases.
