

TO: ALL WIC VENDORS

SUBJECT: REMOVAL OF QUAKER CORN BRAN CRUNCH FROM THE AUTHORIZED LIST

OF BREAKFAST CEREALS

Purpose The California Department of Public Health/Women, Infants, and Children

(CDPH/WIC) Division is notifying all WICauthorized vendors of an upcoming change in which Quaker Corn Bran Crunch will be removed as an authorized

breakfast cereal from the WIC Authorized Food List.

Background Quaker Corn Bran Crunch was reformulated and no longer meets federal

breakfast cereal requirements. As of December 21, 2017, Quaker Corn Bran Crunch will no longer be authorized for purchase with California WIC benefits.

Action for Vendors Share with your staff that as of December 21, 2017, Quaker Corn Bran Crunch will no longer be authorized for purchase with California WIC benefits. The "WIC Foods" page of the WIC Mobile Website will be updated by December 21, 2017 with an image and language indicating that Corn Bran Crunch is no longer

authorized. You may cross out the Corn Bran Crunch in Shopping Guides used

by staff starting on December 21, 2017.
