Bagley Keene Open Meeting Act

 1. Any discussions of 3 or more people will become a public document
 2. Quorum - is minimum number of persons required to be present to conduct business of that group, usually set in by-laws
 3. Subcommittees must follow same rules as regular meetings.

- Targeting malpractice insurers and risk management departments were included as priorities

- Outreach to the general public was deprioritized
- Additional target audiences were added for clarification for education and outreach recommendations
- Outreach to dialysis centers was removed as injection safety is already incorporated into a separate CDPH HAI Program project.
