## All Facilities Letter (AFL) Summary

This AFL notifies GACHs, APHs, SHs and hospice facilities of the chaptering of SB 322 (<u>Chapter 72</u>, <u>Statutes 2019</u>) which specifically grants employees or their representatives the right to discuss privately any possible regulatory violations or patient safety concerns with an inspector during the course of an investigation or inspection by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH).

Effective January 1, 2020, SB 322 specifies that employees or their representatives working in GACHs, APHs, SHs and hospice facilities have the right to discuss privately any possible regulatory violations or patient safety concerns with an inspector during the course of an investigation or inspection by CDPH.

CDPH's failure to expressly notify facilities of statutory or regulatory requirements does not relieve facilities of their responsibility for following all laws and regulations. Facilities should refer to the full text of all applicable sections of HSC and the California Code of Regulations to ensure compliance.
