






of the state's newly reported chronic hepatitis B cases are among Asian & Pacific Islanders (API)




3 out of 10 of all API in the U.S. live in California



## Protect your patients with proper clinical management:


### Screen



- Screen patients born in or who have a parent from any Asian country, Pacific island and other countries with high rates of hepatitis B.
- Use a hepatitis B surface antigen test\* (HBsAg).
- Order additional tests to determine acute or chronic infection.


#### Refer





- Refer patients with hepatitis B to a liver specialist.
- Consult with specialist to ensure high risk patients with chronic hepatitis B receive a liver ultrasound every 6 months.

#### Prevent



- Screen close family members, household contacts, and sexual partners for hepatitis B with HBsAg\* and anti-HBc or anti-HBs\*.
- Vaccinate those who are susceptible (negative for HBsAg\*, negative for anti-HBc, and negative for anti-HBs\*.
