# **Protect Yourself and Your Family from COVID-19**

## Get Vaccinated & Boosted - It's Safe, Effective, and Free

<u>All COVID-19 vaccines currently available in California</u> are safe and effective at preventing serious illness from COVID-19. Vaccination will protect you and those you love. All Californians ages 5+ should get vaccinated. Those eligible should get boosted. To get vaccinated or boosted visit MyTurn.

#### Wear a Mask When Required and Recommended and Wear a Good One

Masking is still a useful tool to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. Choose a good mask that fits well and has good filtration. A KN95, KF94 or N95 is best, or a surgical mask with a cloth mask on top is also a good option. California requires masking at all times in health care settings. In shelters and detention centers masks are required when <u>CDC COVID-19</u> <u>Community Levels</u> are at medium or high levels. Keep in mind local areas may have stricter rules than the state. # Stay Home and Get Tested If You're Sick

Stay home if you're feeling sick and get tested if you have COVID-19 <u>symptoms</u>, even if you're vaccinated and boosted. Read our <u>testing guidance</u>.

#### Seek Treatment

If you test positive and have symptoms, reach out to a health care provider to learn more about <u>COVID-19 treatments</u> or visit a <u>Test to Treat location</u>, where you can get tested and treatment at one location. Remember, treatments are not a substitute for the vaccine, which offers the best protection against COVID-19.

## Ventilate Indoor Spaces

Good indoor ventilation reduces COVID-19 risk. Keep windows and doors open when possible, run heating and air systems, and use portable air cleaners. Read our <u>ventilation fact sheet</u>.

## **Follow Public Health Travel Guidelines**

Follow <u>CDC travel guidelines</u> when traveling locally, domestically and internationally. California strongly recommends masks on public transportation and indoors in U.S. transportation hubs.
