
## WALLEY FEVER IS ON THE RISE IN CALIFORNIA

Valley fever is a disease caused by breathing in a fungus that lives in the soil and dirt in parts of California. For some, it can be serious and even fatal.

## PLACES WHERE VALLEY FEVER IS COMMON

The fungus grows in the soil throughout the southwestern US, with 97% of cases reported in Arizona and California.
