		This event is in compliance with all current local and state public health recommendations and K-12 school public health recommendations and requirements.
		This event is utilizing strategies to improve <u>ventilation</u> , filtration and air quality indoors.
		This event will make outdoor spaces available for attendees.
		This event is following safe food and drink preparation and consumption practices.
		This event is encouraging all attendees to sign up for <u>CA Notify</u> as an added layer of protection for themselves and the community to receive alerts when they have been in close contact with someone who tests positive for COVID-19.
		This event will not prevent anyone who chooses to mask from entry into the event.
Staff:		
		Teachers and school staff are <u>vaccinated</u> or have tested negative prior to working this event.
		Teachers and school staff will be wearing masks throughout the entire event when indoors and have been properly trained on how to wear a <u>well-fitting mask</u> .
		Teachers and school staff, prior to leaving home, have been informed to monitor their own health and stay home if sick or have <u>symptoms</u> .
		All teachers and school staff have been encouraged to sign up for <u>CA Notify</u> as an added layer of protection for themselves and the community to receive alerts when they have been in close contact with someone who tests positive for COVID-19.
		Teachers and school staff are fully trained on all protective measures that are in place for this event.
Attendees:		
		The school will notify attendees if they are required to show proof of <u>vaccination status</u> or show proof of negative tests results prior to attending.
		The school will notify attendees if they will be required to mask during the entirety of the event when indoors, unless actively eating or drinking.
		The school will be providing masks for all attendees that don't have one.
		The school will be providing on-site testing for all attendees.
