Things to do before giving this tailgate training

- Have the crew bring personal fall restraint or arrest equipment. Prepare to have someone demonstrate how to wear the gear and review manufacturers' recommendations.
- Review Key Training Points on the back of card 4a (different areas can be covered at several tailgates).
