Low Level Radioactive Waste Reporting Requirements for Brokers

To All Applicable Radioactive Materials Licensees and Other Entities Required to Report Annually LLRW:

Pursuant to Health and Safety (H&S) Code, Section 115000.1, the California Department of Public Health, Radiologic Health Branch, is required to prepare an annual report regarding low level radioactive waste (LLRW). H&S Code 115000.1, (c)(3)(E) requires that the report include "The identification of all brokers or agents to which LLRW was transferred and the volume and activity by class of the generator's LLRW transferred by each broker or agent to each licensed LLRW disposal facility."

The Department is now requiring that brokers provide an annual report of the volume and activity, by class, of the LLRW transferred by the broker to a licensed LLRW disposal facility. This required report should only include LLRW transferred to a licensed LLRW disposal facility, and not other waste or LLRW transferred for any other purpose. The department understands that brokers or agents may not currently be tracking this information. Accordingly, the new reporting requirement shall be effective beginning January 1, 2023 for the reporting year of 2022.
