Subject: Local Agency Staff Requirements

Item: Degreed Nutritionist (DN): Requirements and Responsibilities

PURPOSE:

To define the roles and responsibilities for a Degreed Nutritionist (DN) in a local agency (LA) setting.

POLICY:

I. The DN must possess a bachelor's degree in a nutrition-related field. The degree may have been earned from institutions within or outside the United States. A DN does not require WNA certification to perform the tasks described in this policy. The DN must work under the supervision of a Registered Dietitian (RD).

PROCEDURE(S):

- Requirements
 - A. If the degree is not listed, consult your Regional Nutritionist for approval. Degrees related the Nutrition Fields are as follows:
 - 1. Public Health Nutrition.
 - 2. Nutrition.
 - 3. Dietetics.
 - 4. Nutrition Science.
 - 5. Food and Nutrition.
 - 6. Food Science.
 - 7. Nutrition and Health.
 - 8. Community Nutrition.
 - 9. Home Economics with nutrition emphasis.
 - B. The LA must complete and maintain the DN Standards for Competency worksheet and review college transcripts. A RD must then review and approve the worksheet. Upon request, the LA shall provide CDPH/WIC with verification of the DN's qualifications.
 - C. If an employee has previous WIC experience, the LA must request and retain copies of these forms and documents from the previous agency or from the employee.
 - D. A LA must retain the verification forms and documents for a minimum of three years following the termination of an employee.

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- E. Every five years a DN must complete 50 continuing education units that are equivalent to those allowable for a RD or Dietetic Technician, Registered.
- II. Responsibilities
 - A. DNs with bachelor's degrees may provide services to participants with any nutrition need.
