CERTIFICATION

Subject: Designated Recipients of Food Benefits

Item: Family Representative

PURPOSE:

To define who is the family representative and the roles and responsibilities.

POLICY:

I. Family Representative

- A. The individual who applies for WIC benefits and receives the California WIC Card assigned in the WIC Web Information System Exchange (WIC WISE). This can be:
 - 1. The individual as a pregnant or postpartum applicant. Another individual cannot be the family representative in a family with a Pregnant or Postpartum category participant.
 - 2. The natural, adoptive, or foster parent applying on behalf of the infant or child.
 - A non-parental adult who has temporary or permanent legal guardianship, or who is caring for the infant or child in cases of abandonment, incarceration, or incapacitation of the parents.
 - a. Documentation of temporary or permanent guardianship is required either at time of certification or within 30 days. Local agency (LA) staff must document in WIC WISE "Notes".
 - b. In situations where there is no documentation and requiring documentation would present a barrier to participation, LA staff must document in WIC WISE "Notes".
- B. The family representative can perform all WIC-related requirements on behalf of themselves, infants, and children participants. Refer to WPPM 1000-130.
- C. The family representative must provide proof of identity at all appointments. Refer to WPPM 270-20.

II. Custody

- A. Legal documentation of parental proof is not required unless custodial rights between parents are in question. WIC services are provided to the parent that applies first and is determined eligible.
- B. When custody is in question, custodial proof and documentation of temporary or permanent custody includes but is not limited to:
 - Records that prove a higher percentage of custody for the parent or guardian disputing custodial rights.

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2. Documentation from other state or federal public assistance programs confirming the individual applying to WIC on behalf of the infant or child is the recipient of benefits on the infant/child's behalf.
