SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) MOLECULAR DIAGNOSTIC TESTING GUIDANCE

Appropriate Clinical Specimens for SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) Molecular Diagnostic Testing

Testing Method	Recommended Specimens
SARS-CoV-2 real time RT-PCR (TaqPath™ COVID-19 Combo Kit)	Respiratory Specimens (NP, nasal, or OP swabs in transport media; NP aspirate; BAL)

Specimen shipment to VRDL requires prior consultation with your local public health department.

Specimen Collection

For respiratory specimen collection, refer to the CDC's <u>Interim Guidelines for Collecting and Handling of Clinical Specimens for COVID-19</u>
<u>Testing.</u>

Specimen Storage

Store respiratory specimens at 2-8°C for up to 72 hours after collection. If a delay in testing or shipping is expected, store specimens at -70°C or below.

Shipping to the VRDL

To ship approved specimens:

 Electronically complete the <u>VRDL General</u> <u>Purpose Specimen Submittal Form</u> for EACH SPECIMEN:

<u>Test(s) Requested:</u> SARS-CoV-2 PCR <u>Vaccine details:</u> date(s) of administration and manufacturer of SARS-CoV-2 vaccine, if applicable

<u>Laboratory data:</u> if previously tested, include previous test results and specimen

information

<u>Clinical Findings and Symptoms:</u> symptoms and onset date, travel history, and outbreak name/location, if applicable

- Include hard copy of the VRDL General Purpose Specimen Submittal Form with shipment. Handwritten forms or forms with stickers will not be accepted.
- Notify the VRDL by secure email to <u>VRDL.Mail@cdph.ca.gov</u>.
- Ship approved specimens to:

- Ship refrigerated specimens on cold packs or frozen specimens on dry ice for same-day or overnight arrival Monday through Thursday.
